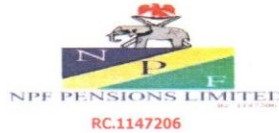

**REPORT OF THE INDEPENDENT AUDITORS ON THE SUMMARY FINANCIAL STATEMENTS TO THE MEMBERS OF NPF PENSIONS LIMITED – RETIREMENT SAVINGS ACCOUNT FUND I FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2022**

**Opinion**

The summary financial statements which comprise the summary statement of net assets as at 31 December 2022 and the summary statement of changes in net assets for the year then ended are derived from the audited financial statements of NPF Pensions Limited Retirement Savings Account Fund I ("the Fund") for the year ended 31 December 2022.

In our opinion, the accompanying summary financial statements are consistent, in all material respects, with the audited financial statements, in accordance with the requirements of the International Financial Reporting Standards, the Companies and Allied Matters Act 2020, the Pension Reform Act 2014 and the Financial Reporting Council of Nigeria Act No 6, 2011.

**Summary financial statements**

The summary financial statements do not contain all the disclosures required by the International Financial Reporting Standards, the Pension Reform Act and the Financial Reporting Council of Nigeria Act applied in the preparation of the audited financial statement of the Fund. Therefore, reading the summary financial statements and the auditors' report thereon is not a substitute for reading the audited financial statements and the auditors' report thereon. The summary financial statements and the audited financial statements do not reflect the effects of event that occurred subsequent to the date of our report on the audited financial statements.

**The audited financial statements and our report thereon**

We expressed an unmodified audit opinion on the audited financial statements in our report dated 18 April 2023.

**Emphasis of matter**

**Bill for the Exemption of Police Officers from the Contributory Pension Scheme (CPS)**

We draw attention to note 18 of the full financial statements of NPF Pensions Limited – RSA Fund I as at 31 December 2022, which relates to a bill before the National Assembly to exempt the Nigeria Police Force (NPF) from the Contributory Pension Scheme (CPS).

The Management and Board of the Fund's Administrator working with the Pension Operators Association of Nigeria (PENOP) and the National Pension Commission (PenCom) have engaged with other critical stakeholders including the Federal Government and the Nigeria Police Force to attend to the complaints by members of the Police Force (Active and Retired) on welfare matters outside of the Scheme and thus ensure the continuity of the CPS. All critical stakeholders are agreed that the success of the bill will impose an industry wide challenge as well as disrupt the financial management of the Federal Government and should be avoided.

During the year, the Government communicated its position for the Nigeria Police Force to continue to be covered under the contributory Pension Scheme.

Our opinion is not modified in respect of this matter.

**The Fund Administrator's Directors' responsibility for the summary financial statements**

The Directors are responsible for preparation of the summary financial statements in accordance with the International Financial Reporting Standards, the Companies and Allied Matters Act 2020, the Pension Reform Act 2014 and the Financial Reporting Council of Nigeria Act No. 6, 2011.

**Auditors' responsibility for the summary financial statements**

Our responsibility is to express an opinion on whether the summary financial Statements are consistent, in all material respects, with the audited financial statements based on our procedures which were conducted in accordance with the International Standards on Auditing (ISAs) 810 (revised) "Engagement to Report on summary Financial Statements".

**Report on other legal and regulatory requirements**

In accordance with our full audit report, we confirm that the Fund complied with the sixth schedule of the Companies and Allied Matters Act 2020.

The summary financial statements disclosed were derived from the full financial statements of NPF Pensions Limited Retirement Savings Account Fund I for the year ended 31 December 2022 and cannot be expected to provide a full understanding of the financial performance, financial position and cash flows of the Fund. The Fund's auditors issued an unqualified opinion on the full financial statements for the year ended 31 December 2022 from which the summary financial statements were derived. The full financial statements from which these summary financial statements were derived can be obtained from the Fund Administrator.
